



## LIFETIME ACHIEVEMENT PERFORMANCE DOG AWARD

### **Application Form**

Goal: To award the dog that performs at the highest levels of the multi-venues of AKC recognized performance sports. This is designed a lifetime award rather than a yearly award.

Criteria: **Dog must have earned titles in at least two (2) of the core sports:** Agility, Obedience, Rally and Tracking. The owner must have significantly trained and handled the dog to its titles. (This does not include conformation titles. Consideration will be given for handler injury and/or physical impairment). Dog must **have achieved the most recent title within 3 years** of the date of the nomination.

Note: Once the dog (not owner/handler) has been awarded the Lifetime Achievement Performance Dog Award, the dog is retired (ineligible) from receiving the award in future years. The owner/handler may apply to receive the award with other dogs he/she owns. If the nominated dog is not given the award, the owner may apply again for consideration of the same dog in a subsequent year.

Award Selection Committee: A Lifetime Achievement Performance Award Selection Committee will be appointed by the current LTDTC President. The committee will be comprised of 5 LTDTC members (3 LTDTC board members and 2 LTDTC non-board members). No selection committee members may be a current nominee. The committee will review all applications and vote to determine **one (1) recipient for the year**
